#### Amos 1:1-2; 5:12-15, 21-24

1The words of Amos, who was among the shepherds of Tekoa, which he saw concerning Israel in the days of King Uzziah of Judah and in the days of King Jeroboam son of Joash of Israel, two years before the earthquake.

2 And he said:

The LORD roars from Zion and utters his voice from Jerusalem; the pastures of the shepherds wither, and the top of Carmel dries up.

- 23 Take away from me the noise of your songs; I will not listen to the melody of your harps.
